Meeting Times/Places: Every Saturday at 9:30 A.M. in the Metro Jail Chapel

Mission / Vision: The mission of the Metro Jail Ministry is to spiritually rehabilitate men and women who have been incarcerated. Spiritual rehabilitation comes by sharing God's Word to inmates through education, counseling and encouraging them to become leaders in their family, on jobs and in their community.

Scripture: For I was an hungered, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. - Matthew 25:35-36.

Activities: Visits to Metro Jail on Saturday mornings with a spiritual message to inmates of their responsibility to God and to themselves.

Ministry Leader's Message: "This ministry is always in need of those who are committed to spreading the word of God to inmates. We encourage all male and female members to come and join us each Saturday morning."

Spiritual Gifts

Miracles

Mark 11:23-24

If the power of God were to be absent from the church, would we still function? When the gift of Miracles is operating in the church, God calls people with this gift to ask for His favor and blessings on the church. When difficulties come and there seems to be no natural solution, God calls people with this gift to pray and trust Him so that His glory may inspire believers. The result is a healthy church trusting and praising God for great things. Do you have a spiritual burden to trust God in seemingly impossible situations? Has this burden led you to pray and ask God to display His power for His glory? Do you have a deep belief in God's ability to fulfill His will in situations?

Tithing

Tithing is a test of our stewardship over the property of God, a test of our honesty to return to God what is rightfully His, a test of our obedience to do what He told us to do, and a test of our love and desire to please Him with our lives. Tithing is also a demonstration that we believe in God, and that we acknowledge that He is the provider of all material blessings.

Tithing (10% of your income) gives God a chance to prove He exists and wants to bless you. Start tithing and watch what happens!
