We need senior adult volunteers to help this ministry provide such services as visitation to homebound persons, nursing homes, hospitals and telephone reassurance.

Mission Statement & Goal: The mission of the Young Adult Ministry is to develop and enrich the spiritual lives of young adults by raising up a new generation of saints committed to a life of worship, with a passion to be mature ambassadors of Christ. Tithing

The Rev. Dr. Lemuel and Ezonia Taylor Scholarship

The Highpoint Baptist Church College Ministry was established by Rev. Dr. Lemuel and Sis. Ezonia Taylor to support our members who decided to pursue their education beyond high school. In 2010, the first Highpoint Baptist Church scholarship was awarded. Because of the Taylors' commitment to this ministry and education, the name of the scholarship changed in 2011 to The Rev. Dr. Lemuel and Ezonia Taylor Scholarship. Since that time, five members have benefited from the scholarship funds. Each year, scholarships are awarded for first place (\$2,000), second place (\$1,000) and third place (\$500) to our deserving members who turn in a completed application packet and complete the entire process. The funds are dispersed in \$500 increments each semester until the awarded funds are received. In order to be good stewards of the church's finances, the ministry has established criteria for the members who submit an application each year. The application process includes: a completed application submitted by the deadline, two letters of recommendation, a high school transcript, a written essay and an interview conducted by a panel of Highpoint members. The ministry will graciously accept any donations toward the scholarship fund. Please feel free to contribute anytime during the year by placing your donation in the envelope and writing "Scholarship Ministry" on the "Other" line. All scholarship recipients will be eternally grateful for your contribution.
