

### ADMINISTRATION

i Cor. 12:28


The gift of Administration is the God-given ability to organize and manage people, resources and time for effective ministry. Often the mark of an administrator is the ability to accomplish things in a "fitting and orderly way". People with the gift of administration are concerned with the details of how to accomplish tasks, and tend to have discernment to recruit others for ministry according to their gifts and talents. The Holy Spirit enables them to motivate, direct and inspire people in such a way that they remain on task and work together to accomplish God-given goals and directives effectively.

## **Ministry Connection**

A person with the gift of Administration can:

- \*Develop strategies or plans to reach identified goals
- \*Put things together, tie up all the "loose ends", get things done and coordinate a variety of activities with ease
- \*Track progress and evaluate the effectiveness of programs, events and procedures
- \*Assist ministries to become more effective and efficient

## **Tithing**

Psalm 116:12 - "What shall I render unto the Lord for all his benefits toward me?" Tithing expresses my gratitude to God for the blessings He's given me. "How can I repay the Lord for all his goodness to me?" The answer - Deuteronomy 16:17 "Each of you should bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you."
