How can I utilize my talents/spiritual gifts to honor God and bless the membership?

## Use Your Spiritual Gifts to Help Highpoint Grow

God has given you at least one spiritual gift. Those gifts aren't just for your own benefit; their purpose is to bless the entire Body of Christ. When you discover your spiritual gift(s) and use them, you'll see amazing growth take place in our church. Here's how you can use your spiritual gifts to help Highpoint grow:

**Realize that you may likely have more than one spiritual gift.** Know that God expects you to use all of the gifts He has given you as you serve Him. Experiment with as many gifts as you can by looking for needs in our church and trying to meet them.

**Be thankful rather than proud.** Humbly be grateful to God for giving you whatever spiritual gift(s) He has. Don't think of yourself more highly than you ought, but also realize that you are a valuable person whom God wants to use.

**Discover your unique gifts.** Remember that there are four prerequisites to discovering your gifts: You have to be a Christian; you have to believe in spiritual gifts; you have to be willing to do the work necessary to use your spiritual gifts; and you have to pray for God's guidance.

What are some ways I can utilize my God-given treasures to honor God and bless the Highpoint Ministries?

## Tithing

The Lord promises to bless us as we faithfully pay our tithes and offerings. He said, "Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it." - Malachi 3:10 KJV

Tithing (10% of your income) gives God a chance to prove He exists and wants to bless you. Start tithing and watch what happens!
